
Commissioning

- · Place the light fitting over the top lip at the top of the wall back and gently push towards the wall until the light fitting is flush with the wall back. Make sure the seal is evenly spread around the wall back and metal tabs are in place to ensure ingress projection.
- · Refit the light fitting with the grub screws set aside earlier. Do not overtighten.
- · Replace fuse or circuit breaker and switch on. Your light is now ready for use.

PIR Adjustment

- The unit must be installed in a vertical position, and fitted 1.8-2.5m above the ground.
- The PIR sensor can be adjusted, allowing the detection distance to be altered to suit the location. The detection angle is set at 120 degrees. The

duration that the lamp stays on can be altered from (10 ± 5) seconds - (5 ± 1) minutes. The detection distance "SENS" can be adjusted up to 8m. A small tool may be required to adjust the controls. When adjusting in daylight it will be necessary to cover the sensor to simulate night time.



To access the adjustment screws, flip down the black cover over the PIR sensor.

Fitting/replacing bulbs

by turning 'SENS' screw

• The LED module in this product is non replaceable.

Detection range can be adjusted

We recommend cleaning with a soft dry cloth. Do not use solvents or abrasive cleaners as these could damage the finish.

Glass parts – Wash with warm water or just use a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive materials as this will damage the finish.

This light fitting should be connected to a circuit with a 30mA RCD fitted.

If replacing an existing fitting, make a careful note of the connections. This system contains non-replaceable parts and cannot be serviced. If damage occurs the part should be scrapped.

This product is rated at IP44.

This product is not suitable for dimming.

Layout


- Plan the desired layout of this fitting carefully, ensuring the cables will reach the distance between the junction box and the light fitting
- Avoid locating any cables in positions that would cause a hazard. Position cables and junction boxes (not supplied) away from areas where they may be at risk from being cut, trapped or damaged
- Cables in walls must be protected using suitable conduit or plastic trunking.

- The mains supply cable must have a minimum cross sectional area of 1.0mm²
- This product has special protection against the ingress of moisture and is IP44 rated.

Installation

Existing fittings must be completely removed before installation of a new product. Before removing the existing fitting, carefully note the position of each set of wires.


- Undo the grub screws located on the bottom of the product with the supplied allen key to separate the light fitting from the wall back. Keep screws safe for refitting later.
- Using the wall back as a template, mark the position of the mounting holes.
- Drill holes and fit supplied wall plugs (suitable for masonry only - for other surfaces use appropriate fixings). Pierce the grommet with a sharp object, such as a screwdriver and feed the incoming mains supply cable through the entry hole grommet. Fix the wall back to the wall using the supplied fixings.
- · Wire as detailed below.



Wiring

Having correctly identified the wiring from your existing light fitting and connect to the connection block inside

the product in the following way:



Check that...

- · You have correctly identified the wires.
- . The connections are tight.

 No loose strands have been left out of the connection block.
